

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INTRODUCTION

Course training program on the discipline is based on the Syllabus on «The History of State and Law of Ukraine» and «Methodical instructions for the development and execution of training and work syllabus of disciplines», implemented by the Order from 16.06.15 № 37/order.

2.2. Homework

Homework is accomplished during 1 and 2 semesters in accordance with approved methodological recommendations in order to consolidate and deepen the theoretical knowledge and skills of students and it is an important stage during the mastering of the educational material, which is taught in the 1st semester.

4.7. The final semester rating grade is entered into the student's grade book and student card, for example: **92 / Excellent / A, 87 / Good / B, 79 / Good / C, 68 / Satisfactory / D, 65 / Satisfactory / E**, etc.



4.8. The final rating grade on the subject is defined as an arithmetic mean grade, taken from the final semester rating grades in points (on this subject - for the first and second semesters), followed by its transfer to the national scale and ECTS scales.

The indicated summary rating grade on the subject is entered into the Appendix to the diploma.
