

Методичні рекомендації з самостійної роботи студентів з опанування навчального матеріалу з навчальної дисципліни «Лінгвокраїнознавство Великої Британії»

Самостійна робота студента є основним видом засвоєння навчального матеріалу у вільний від аудиторних занять час. Зміст СРС з конкретної дисципліни визначається робочою навчальною програмою з цієї дисципліни, навчально-методичними матеріалами, завданнями та вказівками викладача.

З навчальної дисципліни «Лінгвокраїнознавство Великої Британії» самостійна робота студентів передбачає:

- опанування лекційного матеріалу;
- самостійне вивчення теоретичних питань програми, що винесені на самостійне вивчення;
- робота з рекомендованими відеоматеріалами з тематики дисципліни;
- підготовку презентації у застосунку Power Point із обраної теми;
- підготовку до написання поточних тестів та модульної контрольної роботи.

Теоретичні питання, що винесені на самостійне вивчення:

Самостійна робота студентів спрямована на подальше формування лінгвокультурологічної компетенції, розвиток та розширення світогляду студентів у культурологічному аспекті, збагачення словникового запасу студента, розвиток навичок правильного структурного оформлення усного та писемного мовлення. Теми, що винесені на самостійну роботу, розглядаються на лекціях частково, або взагалі не охоплені, тому до уваги студентів пропонується наступний перелік тем для самостійного опрацювання:
