2.2.3.1. Homework

Homework is done on the basis of educational material, delivered on a self-study students, and is an integral part of the module " Management of some aspects of the economic activity of the enterprise ".

The specific objective of homework contains depending on the version of the problem to manage certain aspects of the economic activity of the enterprise.

For the successful implementation of HW the student should know the principles of formation and operating income; process of cost management and capital structure of the enterprise; strategy and ways to reduce operating costs; method of calculation of reserves for increase of production efficiency; be able to carry out structural analysis of the object of study; develop the concept of further development of the object of the study; to analyze the factors influencing managerial decision-making.
