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The Course Training Program on "Macroeconomics" is developed on the basis of the Educational and Professional Program, "Management of Foreign Economic Activity", "Logistics", "Aviation Logistics", "Management Of Airlines and Airports" Bachelor's Curriculums № CB-7-073-2/21, № CB-7-073-3/21, № CB-7-073-5/21 and Bachelor's Extended Curriculum № ECB-7-073-2/21, № ECB -7-073-3/21, № ECB -7-073-5/21 for the Specialty 073 "Management" and corresponding normative documents.

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INTRODUCTION

The Course Training Program (CTP) on "Macroeconomics" is developed based on the "Methodical guidelines for the development and design of the course training program of the subject of full-time and part-time study", approved by the order of the rector N 249/од. of 29.04.2021 and corresponding regulatory documents.

1. EXPLANATORY NOTES

1.1. Place, objectives, tasks of the subject

This discipline is the theoretical and practical basis of the set of knowledge and skills that form the profile of a management specialist.

The purpose of teaching the discipline is to form a system of knowledge about the mechanisms of functioning of the national economy on the basis of modern macroeconomic theories, concepts, models, based on world and domestic science and tested by economic practice.

The tasks of studying the subject are:

- research of theories of macroeconomic development;
- mastering the methods of macroeconomic research;
- analysis of the main indicators of macroeconomic development;
- study of the main mechanisms of macroeconomic regulation;
- acquaintance with the general tendencies of economic processes at the macro level.

1.2. Learning outcomes the subject makes it possible to achieve

As a result of studying the discipline the student must achieve the following learning outcomes:

- demonstrate knowledge of theories and concepts of macroeconomics;
- master the methods of macroeconomic analysis;
- be able to use the tools of macroeconomic research;
- substantiate the consequences of macroeconomic policy;
- assess general macroeconomic trends.

1.3. Competences the subject makes it possible to acquire

As a result of studying the discipline the student must acquire the following competencies:

- ability to analyze the features of macroeconomic policy under different initial conditions of the economy, to develop measures of macroeconomic management;
- ability to analyze and assess the consequences of public policy;
- mastery of methods and techniques of scientific research;
- understanding of methodological features of conducting economic research;
- ability to use fundamental economic knowledge in professional activities.
- ability to generate new ideas (creativity).

1.4. Interdisciplinary connections

The discipline "Macroeconomics" is the basis for the study of such disciplines as: "Microeconomics", "State and Regional Management", "Philosophy of Sustainable Development", "Management of Economic Activity" and "Business Process Management", "Management of International Business and Monetary and Credit relations", "International economic relations".

2. COURSE TRAINING PROGRAM ON THE SUBJECT

2.1. The subject content

Training material is structured according to the module principle and consists of **two** educational modules:

Module № 1 «Theoretical aspects of macroeconomic analysis»;

Module № 2 «Mechanisms of macroeconomic regulation of the national economy» that are logically complete, relatively independent, holistic part of the subject, learning of which provides module test and analysis of its performance.



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2.2. Modular structuring and integrated requirements for each module Module №1 "Theoretical aspects of macroeconomic analysis"

Integrated requirements of the module № 1: know the basic macroeconomic theories and understand the philosophy of macroeconomics; know the main indicators of macroeconomic development; know and be able to use the tools of macroeconomic research; understand the modern model of macroeconomic development; be able to analyze the macroeconomic development of Ukraine and other countries.

Topic 1. Macroeconomics as a science

Macroeconomics as a section of economic theory. The main macroeconomic problems and contradictions. Object, subject, subjects and functions of macroeconomics. Methodology of macroeconomics. Basic concepts and tools of macroeconomic analysis. The purpose and objectives of macroeconomics. Evolution and philosophy of macroeconomics. Model of economic cycle. Basic macroeconomic identity.

Topic 2. GDP and other key macroeconomic indicators

System of National Accounts (SNA). Key macroeconomic indicators and the relationship between them. Methods of calculating GDP. Nominal and real GDP. Price index and def la tor. Inflation and deflation of GDP.

Topic 3. Cyclic oscillations. Unemployment and inflation

Economic (business) cycles and their phases. Potential GDP. Unemployment methods of definition and measurement. Types of unemployment, analysis of the factors that determine them. Calculation of changes in GDP under the influence of deviations of unemployment from the natural level. Economic and social consequences of unemployment. Oaken's laws.

Inflation as a macroeconomic phenomenon. Types and causes of inflation.

Topic 4. Aggregate demand and aggregate supply

Aggregate demand. Analysis of the aggregate demand function. Aggregate offer. Analysis of the aggregate supply function of short-term and long-term periods. Theories of the short-run aggregate supply curve. Equilibrium of aggregate supply and demand in the short run: ratchet effect, overheated economy effect, stagflation.

Topic 5. Keynesian model of macroeconomic equilibrium

Keynesian consumption function. Consumption research tools. Investment function, public procurement and taxes. Equilibrium in commodity and financial markets. Keynesian Cross Model. Autonomous cost multiplier. Recession and inflation gaps.

Module № 2 "Mechanisms of macroeconomic regulation of the national economy"

Integrated requirements of the module № 2: be able to use the tools of macroeconomic research; know the basic mechanisms of monetary and fiscal policy; know the structure of the balance of payments and understand the mechanisms for setting the exchange rate; to substantiate us-icers of macroeconomic policy; assess general macroeconomic trends.

Topic 1. Monetary policy

Types and functions of money. Money offer. Monetary aggregates. Deposit multiplier and money base multiplier. Money issuance mechanism.

Money demand model. Types of monetary policy. Monetary policy instruments. The impact of monetary policy on the economy: the policy of "expensive" and "cheap" money. Transmission



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(transmission) mechanism of monetary policy.

Topic 2. Fiscal policy

Types of fiscal policy. Mechanisms of fiscal policy. Laffer curve. Fiscal policy and budget deficit. Effectiveness of fiscal policy. Types of budget deficits. Sources of financing the budget deficit. State debt. External debt management. Mechanisms for reducing external debt in a debt crisis.

Topic 3. Balance of payments

Content and structure of the balance of payments. Display of transactions on the current account, capital account and financial account. Balancing operations. Balance of payments regulation.

Topic 4. Economic growth

The concept and content of macroeconomic policy of economic growth. The essence, factors and types of economic growth. Indicators of macroeconomic growth. Harod-Domar macroeconomic growth model. Neoclassical model of economic growth: capital accumulation (R. Solow model). Growth according to the "golden rule". Method of calculating sources of economic growth. Modern theory of economic growth. Problems of economic growth in different groups of countries: dynamics of economic growth, comparative analysis. The process of macroeconomic growth in Ukraine.
